Net Zero Commitment

Bryson Tractors Ltd recognises the importance of making a full and lasting commitment to reducing the greenhouse gas emissions from our activities, in support of the wider commitment of the world to limit global temperature increases and the impact on the planet.

As a company, **Bryson Tractors Ltd** have made a maximum commitment to Net Zero by taking part in a 12-month Net Zero Grangemouth Supply Chain Accelerator program called the Net Zero Accelerator, delivered by social enterprise – Net Zero Nation. The Accelerator Programme is hosted by Forth Ports.

One of the key outcomes of the programme is meeting the UN Race to Zero objectives to Pledge, Plan, Progress, Publish and Persuade and in doing so, being a Climate Champion. Working within a cohort of companies, we collaborate and support each other in our journeys, to make our business more planet positive whilst working towards our Net Zero ambitions.

Net Zero Nation is a Scottish based social enterprise with a partner network across the United Kingdom. The mission of Net Zero Nation is to help SME's go further and faster towards their Net Zero goals to tackle climate change.

We commit to the following:

1. For our company to achieve Net Zero in line with the Science Based targets set out by the UNFCCC i.e., to achieve Net Zero no later than 2050 and target a 50% reduction in emissions by 2030.
2. To set realistic short and long term targets that are designed to achieve our Net Zero commitments.
3. To report the total Greenhouse Gas emissions of our business, at a minimum, on an annual basis.

The majority of our carbon emissions come from work travel from our sales team and field technicians. New technologies are being adopted to reduce this, both in vehicle technology to reduce actual emissions and also computer technologies to reduce the requirement for travel. We see this as being our main focus over the coming years.

Energy usage within our premises has been much reduced in recent years, and we will continue to monitor this and further reduce as we are able.

Our Benchmark Year is from April 2023 – March 2024. This is the first time Bryson Tractors Ltd has measured and reported on our carbon emissions, committed to reducing our emissions year by year from now on.

Carbon Reduction Actions

Bryson Tractors Ltd will develop the following initiatives that will support the company's strategies to meet Science Based Targets:

- We've joined the Net Zero Nation Accelerator, teaming up with other forward-thinking businesses to measure, manage, and slash emissions over a 12 month programme.
- We pledge to engage our entire team throughout the organisation in the Net Zero transition plan and to encourage our staff to support lower carbon ideas, opportunities, and activities.
- We aim to reduce Business Travel Emissions by introducing a sustainable travel policy encouraging the use of online training where possible, using public transport and lower carbon options when practical to do so. Use of technologies to reduce technician travel for repairs, encouraging remote repairs where possible. This will be implemented during 2024.
- We have made the commitment to complete our carbon emission dashboard on a regular basis. By partnering with Net Zero Nation International, we gain access to their expertise and support in reporting our emissions and how to reduce them, including best practice and insights. We will also promote our activities on social media to encourage others to make lower carbon decisions.
- We will carry out a full review of our supply chain, developing a full plan in 2024 – 2025, followed by the introduction of a sustainable supply chain policy in 2025.
- We aim to carry out a more detailed review of our waste management, and collaborate with the waste management suppliers to develop a management plan in 2024-2025.
- We will continue to monitor our energy usage and efficiency and engage our entire team to encourage further ideas for opportunities to make savings where possible.

Our Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with SECR, PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard and uses the appropriate Government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas company reporting.

The data used to generate our benchmark year has been collected from various sources from both within the company and using assumptions gathered by Net Zero International. We will continue to report our data on Notch on a monthly basis.
